**Wisdom 11:22-12.2** "You are merciful to all because you love all that exists."

**Psalm** I WILL BLESS YOUR NAME FOR EVER, O GOD MY KING.

**2 Thessalonians 1:11-2:2** "The name of Christ will be glorified in you and you in him"

**Luke 19:1-10** "The Son of Man has come to seek out and save what was lost".

In first century Jewish culture, to dine together was to show a bond of fellowship and peace among those at the table. Observant Jews did not generally dine with foreigners and sinners. Yet, Jesus chooses to honor the tax collector, Zacchaeus, by staying at his house.

Even before Jesus comes to his home, Zacchaeus shows himself to be someone in search of salvation.. In his search for salvation, he humbled himself by making a spectacle of himself by climbing a tree. Jesus recognizes the faith of this tax collector and calls him down from the tree. In the hospitality he extends to Jesus and in his conversion of heart, Zacchaeus is raised up by Jesus as a model of salvation.
