The parish is currently in discussion with the Surrey Heath Planning department in relation the plans to build a new parish centre at St Tarcisius site and to sell off the site at St Peter and St John church for housing development. Pre-application advice is provided by planning officers, which outlines how we are likely to determine any subsequent planning application, and any changes that are likely to be needed. Currently the architects employed by the parish are in correspondence with the planning department. The idea is to hold a general planning meeting for consultation when we have more information and are clearer about the future planning applications.
