Deuteronomy 30:10-14 "The Word is very near to you for your observance"

Psalm SEEK THE LORD YOU WHO ARE POOR AND YOUR HEART WILL REVIVE

Colossians 1:15-20 "All things were created through Christ and for Him."

Luke 10:25-37 "Who is my Neighbour"

Jesus he is confronted by a scholar of the law who wants to test him. The lawyer asks what we must do to inherit eternal life. Jesus responds by asking "What is written in the law?" The lawyer quotes Deuteronomy 6:5 which was one of the most important prayers in Judaism, and it was said twice a day. Love of God and love of neighbour are what is required for eternal life. The lawyer tries another question: Who is my neighbour? In the society of Jesus' time, with its distinctions between Jews and Gentiles, men and women, clean and unclean, this was a trick question. Jesus responds with one of the most beautiful of all the parables, the Good Samaritan.
