Wisdom 18:6-9 "You made us glorious by calling us to you."

Psalms HAPPY ARE THE PEOPLE THAT THE LORD HAS CHOSEN AS HIS OWN."

Hebrews 11:1-2,8-19 "Abraham looked forward to a city, designed and built by God"

Luke 12:32-48 "You too must stand ready."

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about servants waiting for the master's return from a wedding banquet, which, even now, can last for a few days in the Middle East. We must be watchful so that even if the master comes after midnight, we will be ready for him. This is what the coming of the Son of Man will be like. The parable reminds us that we should be found doing our jobs when the master arrives. If we are doing our jobs, our reward will be great. But if we relax, neglect our duties, and begin to act like the greedy rich man—eating, drinking, and making merry—we will not have a place in the kingdom. Watchfulness means living in such a consistently moral and obedient way that we are always ready to give an account to God
