Blessed **John Henry Newman** will be canonised by Pope Francis at St Peter's Square, Rome this Sunday, 13 October. Born 21/2/1881 the eldest son of a London banker he studied at Trinity College, Oxford. He was ordained in the Church of England and worked as a Vicar of the University Church. He withdrew from Oxford and for three years led a strict religious life, praying for light and guidance. On 9th October 1845 he was received into the Roman Catholic Church. He was ordained a priest in Rome and founded the first Oratorian Congregation in Birmingham, with a second in London and the Oratory School in Birmingham. In 1879, he was created a cardinal by Pope Leo XIII.
