Sunday Readings

Exodus 32:7-11,13-14 "The Lord relented and did not bring on his people the disaster he had threatened."

Psalm I WILL LEAVE THIS PLACE AND GO TO MY FATHER.

Timothy 1:12-17 "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners."

Luke 15:1-32 "There will be rejoicing in heaven over one repentant sinner".

In chapter 15 of Luke's Gospel, Jesus talks about recovering that which is lost, which is the implicit explanation of why Jesus receives sinners and eats with them: they are lost, and he wants to recover them. Jesus tells the parable of the Prodigal son – a son who left the father to be sinful and wasteful. But when the son had lost everything and came to his senses he returned to the father to beg forgiveness. The Father welcomed his son with open arms. For his son was dead and has come back to life, he was lost and is now found. God the Father celebrates the return of all who were lost and are now found.
