Psalm IN YOUR GOODNESS O GOD YOU PREPARED A HOME FOR THE POOR

Hebrews 12:18-19,22-24 "You have come to Mount Zion, the city of the living God."

Luke 14,1,7-14 "Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and the man who humbles himself will be exalted".

In Luke's Gospel Jesus warns guests to wait before taking their places at the table lest they be asked to move if someone more important arrives. This is more than just a lesson about dinner etiquette. It is advice on how to find your true place in the Kingdom of God. Jesus advises hosts not to invite people who would be expected to repay them to dinner but to invite those who could not repay: the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind. This is where real blessings can be found. Luke gives us not only advice on how to approach the end times but also on how to live according to Jesus' vision of a good society. Luke's Gospel also
