Sunday Readings

Isaiah 8:23-9:3 The people in darkness have seen a great light.

Psalm THE LORD IS MY LIGHT
AND MY HELP

1 Corinthians 1:10-13,17 Be united as people baptized in Christ's name.

Matthew 4:12-23 Jesus begins to preach in Galilee and calls his first disciples.

The first part of today's Gospel Matthew shows that Jesus is the fulfillment of the prophecies given to the people of Israel, and he refers to Isaiah to do so. Isaiah says that the Messiah will begin his ministry in Galilee, the land of the Gentiles. When Jesus begins to preach in Galilee, Matthew points to his ministry as a fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy, proof that Jesus is the Messiah. When Jesus called his first disciples, Peter and Andrew, James and John dropped everything to follow Jesus immediately. What kind of person must Jesus have been to invoke

Rededication of England as the Dowry of Mary Sunday 29th March

The first dedication was made by King Richard II in Westminster Abbey as he sought the protection of Our Lady in the face of great political turmoil. England received the title 'Mary's Dowry'; meaning that England was 'set aside' as a gift, a dowry, for Our Lady under her guidance and protection. The Re-dedication means that we seek Mary's protection and prayers, giving ourselves through an act of dedication.
