### Sunday Readings

**Isaiah 60:1-6** Jerusalem shall be a light to all nations.

**Psalm** ALL NATIONS SHALL FALL

**Ephesians 3:2-3a,5-6** Gentiles are coheirs in the promise of Christ.

**Matthew 2:1-12** The Magi seek out Jesus and do him homage.

The Magi. came from the East and journeyed to Bethlehem, following an astrological sign, so we believe them to be astrologers.. In Matthew's Gospel, they represent the Gentiles' search for a savior. As the Magi also represent our search for Jesus. We have come to consider the gifts they bring as a foreshadowing of Jesus' role in salvation. Gold is presented as representative of Jesus' kingship. Frankincense is a symbol of his divinity because priests burned the substance in the Temple. Myrrh, which was used to prepare the dead for burial, is offered in anticipation of Jesus' death.
