“In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen”

As you **light the candle** pray: Lord Jesus you came as a light that shines in darkness and a light that darkness cannot overpower (Jn: 1:5) – enlighten our hearts and minds to your presence in our midst

#### **Act of Penance**

For the times when we have failed to love God and to love each other we ask for God’s forgiveness.

Lord Jesus, you have revealed yourself as the way to the Father: Lord, have mercy. Lord, have mercy. You have poured out on your people the Spirit of truth: Christ, have mercy. Christ, have mercy. You are the Good Shepherd, leading us to eternal life: Lord, have mercy. Lord, have mercy.

We pray (Pause for Silent Prayer) Almighty and merciful God look with compassion on our affliction, and so lighten your children's burden and confirm our faith that we may always trust without hesitation in your fatherly providence. Through our Lord Jesus Christ your Son, Who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit One God for ever and ever. Amen

### **Psalm 85 (1-6, 11, 15-16)**

Turn your ear, O Lord, and give answer for I am poor and needy.

Preserve my life, for I am faithful: save the servant who trusts in you.

You are my God, have mercy on me, Lord, for I cry to you all the day long.

Give joy to your servant, O Lord, for to you I lift up my soul.

O Lord, you are good and forgiving, full of love to all who call.

Give heed, O Lord, to my prayer and attend to the sound of my voice.

Show me, Lord, your way so that I may walk in your truth.

Guide my heart to fear your name.

You, God of mercy and compassion, slow to anger, O Lord, abounding in love and truth, turn and take pity on me.

### **Gospel Mark 4:35–41**

On that day, when evening had come, Jesus said to them, 'Let us go across to the other side.' And leaving the crowd, they took him with them in the boat, just as he was. And other boats were with him. And a great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking into the boat, so that the boat was already filling. But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion. And they woke him and said to him, 'Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?' And he awoke and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, 'Peace! Be still!' And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. He said to them, 'Why are you so afraid? Have you still no faith?' And they were filled with great fear and said to one another, 'Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?'

- We pray for those who are anxious in these days (Pause) Lord ease their fears and grant them the consolation of your presence.
- We pray for our families and friends (by name) – Lord protect them and look after them
- We pray for a spirit of charity among our fellow country men and women (Pause) Lord, at this time of national crisis, help the people of our country to be generous and to look out for and care for each other.
- We pause to pray for our own private intentions. (Pause to mention intentions) Lord hear my prayer.
- We pray for our loved ones who have died (Pause) Lord enfold them ever more closely in your loving embrace.
- Father, we ask you to hear these our prayers and if it be your will to answer them for we make them in faith and love and trust thorough Christ our Lord, Amen
