**Permanent  
Diaconate**



**Simon Tierney** will be ordained to the permanent diaconate by Bishop Richard Moth at St Tarcisius Church this Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July at 7.00pm.

A deacon is an ordained minister of the Catholic Church. There are three "orders," of ordained ministers in the Church: bishops, priests and deacons. Deacons are ordained as a sacramental sign to the Church and to the world of Christ, who came "to serve and not to be served."

The word *deacon* derives from the Greek *diakonia*, meaning "service," thereby indicating that a deacon is called like Christ to be a servant. The Order of Deacon has three essential functions: the proclamation of the Gospel, the service of the liturgy, and the administration of charitable works. In particular, the deacon may assist the bishop and the priests in a variety of liturgical functions: Deacons may baptize, witness the exchange of vows and bless marriages, distribute Holy Communion, impart benediction with the Blessed Sacrament, bring Viaticum to the dying, read Sacred Scripture to the faithful and especially proclaim the Gospel, preach, officiate at funerals and burials, and administer the sacramentals. They should also dedicate themselves to other charitable works, particularly within the parish community. (Catholic *Catechism*, No. 1569-70)

We pray for Simon, his wife Anne and daughters, Rebekah, Keziah and Hannah at this time of blessing for them. We also pray for our parish that we may all service the mission of the Catholic Church to proclaim the good news and to make disciples of Christ within His Church. As we face a changing future, we're re-committed to being the local catholic church within our area of Camberley and Bagshot and that the Lord may bless us through Simon's ordained ministry in the years to come.

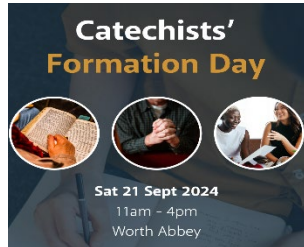
