The Rt Rev Bishop Richard Moth will be celebrating the **Centennial Mass** of **St Tarcisus Church** this Thursday 21st November 7pm (The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary)

In 1906, Fr Patrick Twomey came to Camberley and on the 1st July 1908 started a fund to build a new permanent church. On 12 September 1923, the foundation stone of the church was laid by the Bishop of Southwark - Peter Amigo. On 18 November 1924, the church was opened. The church was designed by Frederick Walters as a War Memorial for fallen British Catholic

military officers in the First World War. The War Memorial Plaque features the names of some 150 officers and men who were at some time or another members of the congregation and who were killed in the Great War of 1914-18.

St Tarcsius was a martyr of the early Christian church who lived in the 3rd century. There was a poem composed in his honour by Pope St Damasus (366–384), who compares him to the deacon Saint Stephen and says that, as Stephen was stoned by a crowd, so Tarcisius, carrying the Blessed Sacrament, was attacked by a group and beaten to death.. He was buried in the cemetery of St. Callistus, and his relics are claimed by the church of San Silvestro in Capite. His feast day is celebrated on 15 August; that day is widely observed as the Feast of the Assumption.

Lord Jesus, I profoundly adore Thee, really present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the altar. May I always act as I believe, and show by my example my belief in the great truths of our Faith. Most Blessed Mary, Mother of our Lord, obtain for me by thy prayers the grace to serve thy Son with reverence and devotion. Saint Tarcisius, pray for me, that I may follow thy example by defending the honour of the Blessed Sacrament all the days of my life and even unto death.
